Along with the champagnes, our Italian sparkling wines are made according to the rigorous “Metodo Classico” production process, with second fermentation in the bottle and over 36 months refinement and ageing on the lees. This is not to be confused with your mass produced 11% “prosecco”. *This is a 12.5% fine sparkling wine.*

Calafuria Salento A soft peach-pink hue with an expressive bouquet of pink grapefruit, ripe peach, rose petals, and cherry blossom. Fresh, poised, and beautifully expressive, with a fine mousse and a long, refined finish, it captures the House style of purity and finesse.</p>	18	100
<p>Laurent-Perrier Héritage 12%</p> <p>Born from the savoir-faire of Grand Siècle, Héritage is a masterful multi-vintage blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from the finest crus of Champagne. Composed exclusively from carefully selected reserve wines, it shows impressive maturity, layering white peach, orchard fruit, and toasted almond with a touch of honeyed brioche. <p>Laurent-Perrier Brut Millésimé Vintage 2015 12%</p> <p>An exceptional Grand Cru vintage, Brut Millésimé 2015 is crafted from a rare selection typically reserved for Grand Siècle. It offers depth and character, with notes of red apple, peach, and candied lemon, complemented by subtle hints of toast and orange. Richly structured yet refined, it expresses the essence of the year in Laurent-Perrier's signature style.</p>		170
<p>Laurent-Perrier Blanc de Blancs Brut Nature 12%</p> <p>Crafted entirely from Chardonnay, this Blanc de Blancs is beautifully precise, defined by its bone-dry, zero-dosage style. Sourced from top Grand and Premier Cru vineyards and aged in stainless steel, it reveals crisp citrus notes of grapefruit, lemon zest, and green apple, underpinned by fine chalky minerality and a clean, focused finish.</p>		190

Chardonnay delle Dolomiti From the Dolomite foothills around Arco, just north of Lake Garda, this Chardonnay is fresh and fruity, with notes of melon and white peach. Beautifully harmonious and easy-drinking. <i>Chardonnay, Trentino-Alto Adige, 12%</i>	7	10	30
Pinot Grigio delle Dolomiti This is an original Pinot Grigio from Trentino, where it should come from. Elegant and dry, with aromas of apple and banana, and a clean, crisp finish ensuring a superb wine. This is the real deal. <i>Pinot Grigio, Trentino-Alto Adige, 12%</i>	7.7	11	33
Feudo Arancio A beautiful combination of tropical mango and papaya, complemented by delicate hints of jasmine and acacia blossom. Refreshing, yet opulently textured, this Grillo offers an elegance rarely seen in this variety. <i>Grillo, Sicilia, 13%</i>	7.7	11	33
Castel Firmian Sauvignon Blanc From a state-of-the-art winery handling estate-grown fruit from its extensive vineyard holdings in the heart of the Dolomites, this Sauvignon offers a dry, citrusy and rounded palate, with notes of lime and green apple, and a delicate mineral finish. It is typical Trentino. <i>Sauvignon Blanc, Trentino-Alto Adige, 12%</i>	9.3	13.3	40
Orvieto Classico Amabile A refined, elegant and medium-dry Orvieto that is soft and gentle on the palate. Vernaccia di San Gimignano The first Italian DOC wine, this Vernaccia is unoaked, fruity and very crisp, with an engagingly intense palate. Full of green apple and almond, leading to an appetising Chablis-like finish. <i>Vernaccia, Toscana, 12.5%</i>	45
Gavi di Gavi One of Piemonte's most celebrated wines. Piemonte has been growing Cortese grapes and making this dry classic white for over 150 years. A pleasantly fresh, dry and crisp Gavi, with hints of green apple, lemon zest and white blossom, offering a harmonious palate with great texture and precision. <i>Cortese, Piemonte, 12.5%</i>	52
Vivia The breathtakingly beautiful Le Mortelle estate has belonged to the Antinori family since 1999. The aromas of Vivia recall ripe peaches, citrus peel and candied fruit, alongside notes of thyme and sage. The palate adds savoury mineral touches and the finish is crisp and persistent. <i>Vermentino, Ansonica, Viognier, Toscana, 12.5%</i>	53
Vette di San Leonardo From the renowned Tenuta San Leonardo estate, whose wines sit firmly in the pantheon of Italy's greatest, this Sauvignon Blanc is crafted from hand-harvested grapes from vines aged between 6 and 15 years. It has delicate flavours of white peach and citrus, with subtle hints of sage. Fresh and precise, a lively acidity enhances its mineral character, leading to a crisp, gently grassy finish. <i>Sauvignon Blanc, Trentino Alto-Adige, 12.5%</i>	55
Vinnae Jermann From the early 1990s, Jermann transcended from visionary to icon. With over 30 Tre Bicchieri awards from Gambero Rosso, Jermann is rightly recognised as one of Italy's finest producers. This white involves being aged in Slavonian oak barrels for 6 months, and has a lively and vibrant expression of medium intensity. Full of fresh and fruity notes, with aromas of green apple, pear, lemon zest, and white blossom. It finishes clean and persistent, with a hint of almond. <i>Ribolla Gialla, Friuli, 12.5%</i>	74
Cervaro della Sala Umbria IGT Antinori acquired the fourteenth-century Castello della Sala in 1940, with a vision to create white wines to rival the excellence of its Tuscan reds. Realised with the introduction of Cervaro della Sala in 1987, it has since become one of Italy's defining whites, as influential and sought-after as Tignanello. Sourced from vineyards aged between 15 and 20 years, it shows complex aromas of white flowers and flint, with a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured, the palate reveals notes of toast, citrus, and minerality, leading to an elegant, lingering finish with excellent ageing potential. <i>Chardonnay, Umbria, 13%</i>	170

A lovely rich red from the Adriatic coast, with notes of dark cherry, plum, and subtle spice. Smooth yet structured, with firm tannins and a warm, rounded finish.

Salice Salentino Riserva Ducale

A classic from the south, this red offers deliciously harmonious mature fruit with notes of black cherry, raisins, tobacco and leather. Rich and well-structured, with a smooth, lingering finish.

Syrah Feudo Arancio

This grape variety is referred to as Syrah in the Old World and Shiraz in the New. Bold and spicy with opulent notes of wild berries, black pepper and thyme, offering a fresh acidity perfectly framed by the lush, velvety tannins.

A great vibrant ruby red with loads of character, this Cabernet is full-bodied and intense, with layers of spicy notes, hints of eucalyptus, dark fruit, and a fragrant scent of oak. A real special treat.

Made using a tradition dating back 1500 years. This wine is dark ruby red with an ample complexity and a real elegant velvety finish that anybody who knows Amarone will appreciate.

This wine needs no introduction. Everyone knows Barolo, for good reason. It is a fabulous intense garnet red wine with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits; delicately perfumed yet persistent on the palate. The best wine from Piemonte, this is Barolo at its best.

Achelo Cortona

A richly expressive Tuscan red, full-flavoured yet delicate, with a complex nose of pepper and tobacco. It shows a supple texture and sweet palate, with a pleasurable persistence highlighting dark fruit notes of blackcurrant and blackberry jam, alongside light hints of vanilla and the typical spicy herbal finish of Tuscany.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano

The noblest wine of Tuscany, many would argue the best. This particular estate lies near Valliano, my father's birthplace. In this region, Sangiovese grapes are called 'Prugnolo Gentile' due to their superior quality. If you enjoy red wine, this is a must. It's full-bodied, rich with a degree of warm spice, and lingering on the palate.

Chianti Classico Riserva

The best known wine in Tuscany. Villa Antinori began life as a Chianti Classico Riserva in 1928 and with the 2011 vintage, it marked the return of this iconic wine and was reinstated to the range. This is a rich modern Chianti that marries beautifully ripe cherry fruit with well-judged smokey oak. The opulence on the palate is tempered by savoury notes of clove, and a firm structure supporting the plump fruit.

Vie Cave Toscana

From the ancient lands of southern Tuscany, this deep ruby red shows an expressive bouquet of ripe black fruit, liquorice and spice. The palate is full-bodied and silky, with excellent depth and structure, revealing layers of blackberry, plum, cocoa and dark chocolate, lifted by hints of black pepper and wild herbs. The volcanic soils and warm coastal climate bring both richness and elegance, leading to a long, smooth and persistent finish. Crafted at Fattoria Aldobrandesca, this is Malbec with an Italian soul.

Brunello di Montalcino

The king of wines. From the beautiful hilltop vineyards of Montalcino, planted up to 480 metres above sea level, this elegant Brunello is made from handpicked Sangiovese grapes and aged in oak for 30 months. It shows an intense fragrance of red fruits and well-rounded tannins. Simply the best.

Tignanello 2020

Tignanello is considered one of the first of the modern Super Tuscan wines, originating from the prestigious Italian winery Marchesi Antinori, and has decisively shaped Italian viticulture. The 2020 vintage offers exceptional complexity, with aromas of red fruits, strawberry and pomegranate, layered with apricot, peach, vanilla and spice. The palate is graceful and balanced, with silky tannins and impressive length, finishing with notes of roasted coffee and bitter chocolate.
